Tift Regional Health System is also the lead partner of Care Alliance, an Accountable Care Organization (ACO) which serves as an approved Medicare Shared Savings Program (MSSP).

In addition, Mr. Richardson is Board Chairman and co-founder of Georgia-based Stratus Healthcare, one of the nation's largest collaborations of hospitals, healthcare systems and physicians aligned to develop a clinically-integrated network. He also serves on the Board of Secure Health.

Before joining TRHS in 1988, Mr. Richardson served as an Assistant Administrator at West Georgia Medical Center in LaGrange, Georgia and later as Administrator at Bulloch Memorial Hospital in Statesboro, Georgia. He earned his master's degree in hospital and health administration from the University of Alabama in Birmingham and his undergraduate degree from the University of South Alabama. He is a Fellow of the American College of Healthcare Executives (FACHE).
