Routine Prescription Refills

Send Routine Medication Refill Requests by E-Scribe®

E-Scribe® provides the fastest response. Please be aware that best practice and legal requirements for refills for pain, opioids and certain other medications, prevent electronic refill orders. In those situations, a written prescription is required. When a refill request of this nature is received via E-Scribe®, our staff will contact the patient within 3 to 5 business days to arrange pick up of the written refill prescription.
